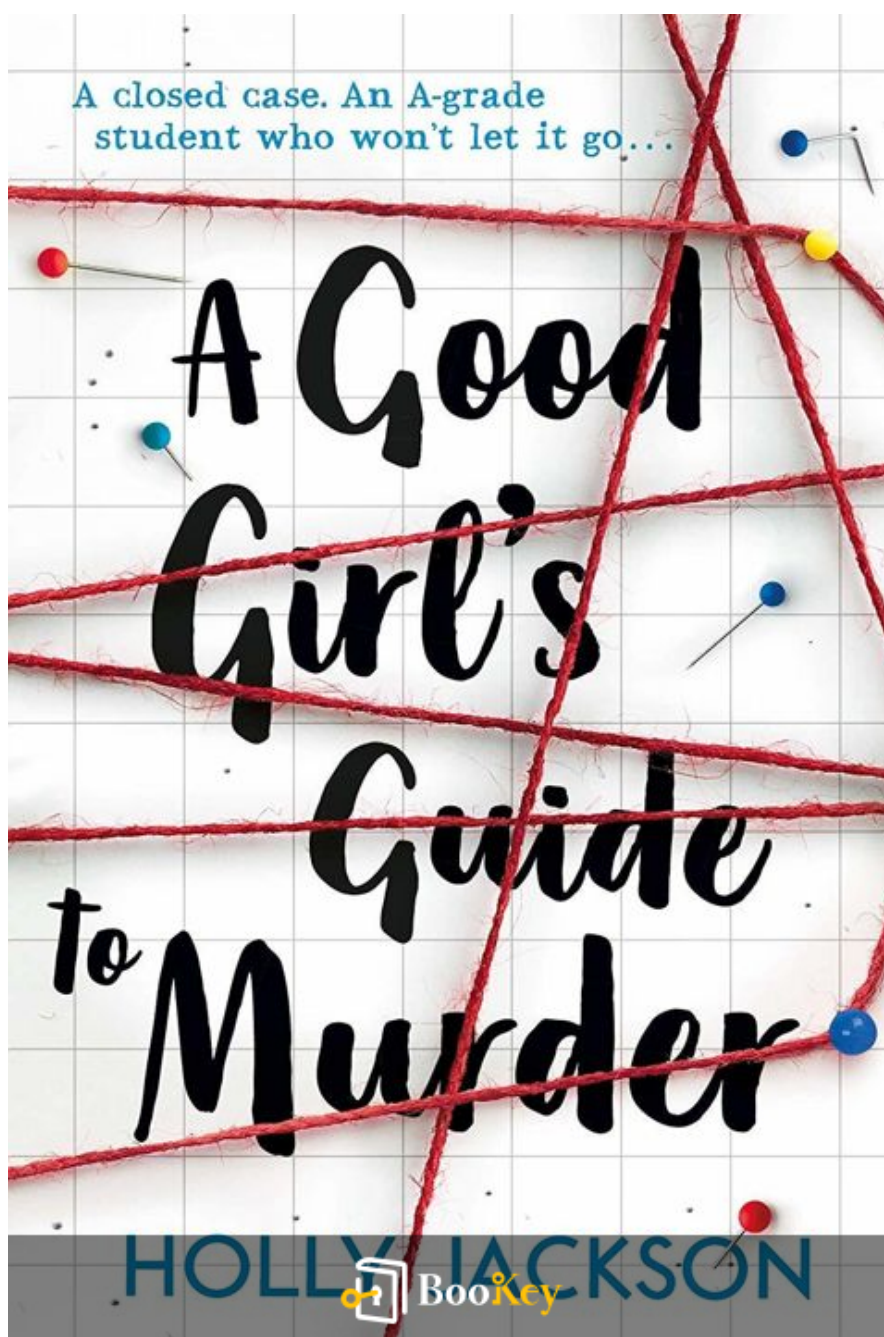

Pippa's narrative concludes with her prepared for her report presentation, reflecting on the transformations her community faces, the complexity of human actions, and the pressing need for understanding and healing—underscoring the cyclic nature of violence and trauma in small towns and the imperative for accountability as she prepares to reclaim Andie's story for voice and truth amid the media frenzy that awaits her.
